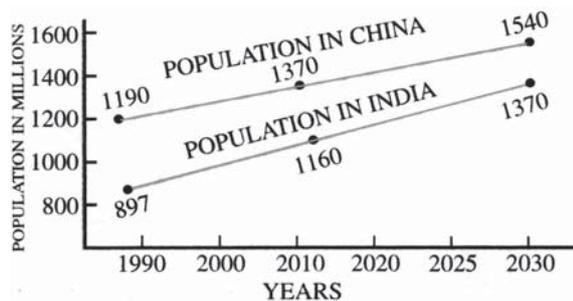

**Context-** The poet has told us about the nature of the Man. He was kind and gentle to all his friends and his foes. When he put on his clothes he thought that he is clothing naked poor man.

**Explanation-** In these lines the poet gives a description of the kind of dogs that were found in that town. But there lived a Dog that was different from all these dogs. The kinds of dogs that lived in that town were dogs of mixed breed, yound dogs, puppies and dogs used for hunting and racing. The dogs of mixed breed were aggressive. They were considered to be the dogs of low breeding.

- (b) **Reference-** These lines refer to the poem "The Lotus". The poem is composed by the poetess Toru Dutt.

**Context-** This stanza is about the claims or argument made by two factions of flower loving poets.

**Explanation-** In these lines the poetess says that one faction is in favour of the rose flower while the other is in favour of the lily flower. The rose camp and the lily camp came in front of each other. Both the camps stood firmly under the cool shade of the psyche trees and plants (psyche's bower) to establish the superiority of their favourite flower.
